### Louise Bruce – The Baker's Daughters

Henry and his wife had two young daughters, Gwyneth and Edith, who tragically drowned in the Wingecarribee River that runs behind the property. This event devastated their family and the small community of Berrima.

I live in the beautiful Southern Highlands village of Berrima, NSW.

I have been singing and gigging for the last fifteen years with jazz band 'Ellas Holiday'. I have always been content singing and interpreting Jazz Standards. In the last 5 years however, I picked up my guitar and started writing songs.
